Even though paper (or what people in the recycling industry call mixed paper) is not accepted for curbside recycling, you can still drop it off at any of the locations listed below:



## What is Considered Mixed Paper?

- Computers/Copy/Colored Paper
- Manila Envelopes
- Business Envelopes (with or without windows)
- Sticky Notes
- Ledger/Scratch Paper
- Adding Machine Tape 
- File Folders
- Junk Mail
- Glossy Paper (brochures/fliers)
- Catalogs/Magazines/Telephone Books
- Newspaper (with or without inserts)
- Corrugated Cardboard (non-waxed only; boxes must be flattened and fit through compartment)
- Paperboard (e.g. shoe boxes, tissue boxes, writing paper tablet backings)
